- 2. Seat.
- 3. Dust cover  
(it is the space between the seat and the backrest).
- 4. Armrest.
- 5. Cupholders.
- 6. Back of the armrest.  
(lift for cleaning)
- 7. Space between seats.
- 8. Under the seat.
- 9. Metallic parts.
- 10. To-back.
- 11. Space between the seats and the step.  
(vinyl floor or carpet).

*NOTE: It is recommended to follow the sequence of the cleaning process in order to avoid making dirt in the area that are already clean.*

## TRADITIONAL LEATHER SEATS CLEANING

#	Area	Specifications	General Indications
1	Backrest	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Verify that there are no stains.</li> <li>• In case of having stains degreaser may be used. However it is recommendable to use only if needed in order to maintain the material of the seat in optimal conditions.</li> </ul>	<p style="writing-mode: vertical-rl; transform: rotate(180deg);">• The general cleaning of the seats is performed with a clean cloth and neutral cleaner.</p>
2	Seat	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For the normal cleaning process always use neutral cleaner.</li> </ul>	
3	Dust cover	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It is very important to check this area of the seat since it is a place that accumulates a large amount of dust and debris.</li> </ul>	
4	Armrest	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Verify that there are no stains or spillovers.</li> </ul>

5	Cupholders		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Verify that there are no popcorn/food or any excess leftover.</li> <li>• Using a spray bottle with a neutral cleaner, soak the cup holders and with a sponge/cloth clean out the insides to remove any leftover liquids or food.</li> <li>• With a dry and clean cloth remove water excess.</li> </ul>	<p><b>• The general cleaning of the seats is performed with a clean cloth and neutral cleaner.</b></p>	
6	Back of the armrest		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Verify that there are no chewing gums in this area of the seat.</li> <li>• Clean the area with a cloth and neutral cleaner.</li> </ul>		
7	Space between seats		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Verify that there are no popcorn/food or any excess leftover.</li> <li>• Remove any excess before proceeding to wash.</li> <li>• With a little wet brush with only water, clean this area.</li> </ul>		
8	Under the seat		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wipe down the bottom of the seat with a clean cloth and neutral cleaner.</li> <li>• Remove any chewing gum found under the seat.</li> </ul>		
9	Metallic parts		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Verify that there are no popcorn/food or any excess leftover.</li> <li>• With a little brush, dampen with water &amp; a neutral cleaner to clean the metallic part of the seat.</li> <li>• It is very important to clean the vinyl floor in order to prevent the liquids from going under the metallic parts.</li> </ul>		
10	To-back		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wipe down the plastic backing of the seat with a clean cloth and neutral cleaner.</li> <li>• Remove any chewing gum found behind the seat.</li> </ul>		
11	Space between seats		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Verify that there are no popcorn/food or any excess leftover.</li> <li>• With a broom, clean the space between the seats and the floor in order to maintain the integrity of the vinyl floor.</li> </ul>		<p>The general cleaning of the seats is performed with a broom or a mop for the vinyl floor and a cloth to clean the metallic parts with neutral cleaner.</p>
