






1. Backrest.
2. Armrest.
3. Back of the armrest (lift for cleaning).
4. Seat.
5. Cupholders.
6. Tables, lamps and buttons.
7. Metallic parts (recline seat for cleaning).
8. Space between the seats and the step (vinyl floor or carpet).

*NOTE: It is recommended to follow the sequence of the cleaning process in order to avoid making dirt in the area that are already clean.*

#	Area	Specifications	General Indications
1	Backrest	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Verify that there are no stains.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The seats must be vacuumed once a week.</li> <li>• The required cleaning material for the process is a clean cloth and a neutral cleaner.</li> <li>• Degreaser should only be used in case of difficult stains.</li> </ul>
2	Armrest	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In case of visible stains, degreaser can be used, however, it is recommended to only use when necessary. Preferably, it's good to regularly use a neutral cleaner in order to preserve the optimal material condition.</li> </ul>

## LEATHER SEATS CLEANLINESS

#	Area	Specifications	General Indications
4	Seat	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clean and check the areas between the seat that accumulates food &amp; debris.</li> <li>• With a clean cloth and a neutral cleaner proceed to clean the tables, buttons and lamps.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The seats must be vacuumed once a week.</li> <li>• The required materials for this process is a clean cloth and a neutral cleaner.</li> <li>• A degreaser should only be used in case of having difficult stains to remove.</li> </ul>
5	Cupholders	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• With a sponge and neutral cleaner proceed to clean the tables, buttons and lamps.</li> <li>• Using a neutral cleaner, spray the cupholders and with the clean cloth wipe the inside to remove any liquids or food/debris.</li> </ul>	
6	Tables, lamps and buttons	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• With a dry and clean cloth. wipe away any damp excess from the cleaner.</li> </ul>	
7	Metallic parts	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check &amp; clean under the seats of any food, trash, and debris.</li> <li>* All California locations should have a theater &amp; chair pulling schedule to make sure under the chairs are being cleaned regularly.</li> <li>• With separate clean cloth or small brush and degreaser clean the metallic parts.</li> </ul>	
8	Space between the seats and the step (vinyl floor or carpet)	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The seats should be pushed out from the step behind them in order to thoroughly clean them. (If the chairs are electric, please check &amp; disconnect any wires in your way to prevent harm.)</li> <li>• Look for the sides of the seat avoiding to damage the material with the metallic parts.</li> <li>• Check &amp; clean all food, trash, and debris found behind the seat.</li> <li>• With a clean cloth, wipe and clean the space between the seat and the step in order to maintain the integrity of the carpet.</li> </ul>
